

## Harsco Signs Agreement to Provide Logistics Services to Largest Stainless-Steel Mill in Europe

**CAMP HILL, PA (April 3, 2019)** -- Harsco Corporation (NYSE: HSC) today announced that its Metals & Minerals division has signed a seven-year contract to provide onsite logistics services at Outokumpu's stainless-steel site in Tornio, Finland. Under the terms of the \$28 million agreement, Harsco will provide scrap transport using a fleet of fuel-efficient and technologically-advanced trucks. The Tornio site is one of Outokumpu's four integrated plants, and specializes in producing high-performing stainless-steel grades.

The signing of this agreement further expands Harsco's relationship with Outokumpu. It also marks Harsco's first service agreement at a Finnish site, further extending the Company's reach in Europe.

"We are pleased to build on our relationship with Outokumpu, and look forward to helping them to manage their scrap transport safely and efficiently," said Harsco Metals & Minerals Chief Operating Officer Russ Mitchell. "This also is an important strategic win for Harsco, as it expands both our map of operating locations, and our reach into the stainless-steel market."
